All selected participants must compose a new work with a duration of 5-8 minutes for viola solo **or** clarinet, accordion and double bass. The new compositions will be premiered in a final concert on 15 August 2024.

The call is open to composers of all nationalities and ages. People from underrepresented groups are especially encouraged to apply.
